1. **All entries will receive acknowledgement plus numbers, exhibitors' passes and any schedule alterations. Those entering, Fancy Dress or Jumping events on show day, can expect one trailer or lorry driver admitted free and all competing adults and children will be charged £1, additional passengers will be charged full admittance price.**
2. Entry fees will be refunded for a cancellation of entry on condition that a Veterinary Surgeon's Certificate is acquired by the exhibitor. Application for refund must be made in writing to the Show Treasurer enclosing a photocopy of the said Certificate.
3. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to ensure that classes entered do not clash. Classes will not be delayed whilst another class is completed. Exhibitors to be ready to enter the ring 20 minutes before the scheduled time of the class. All times are approximate but every effort will be made to keep to scheduled times.
4. All foals must be at least three weeks old on Show day.
5. Anyone mounted on the show field **MUST** wear protective head gear, as must any child below the age of 13 years showing in In-Hand classes.
6. All exhibitors must ensure that when not partaking in a competition or parade, they confine their horses to the horse walks and horsebox parking area.
7. Prize money must be collected from the Horse Secretary **AFTER** the parade or the same will be forfeited. Prize money will **NOT** be posted.
8. All horses and ponies must hold a valid passport or have applied for one, which must accompany them onto the show ground.
9. **Entries Close Friday 2nd August 2019**
10. **The riders of any horses or ponies that are hacked to the show ground will gain free entry onto the showground. (Rider only).**
11. **Classes 11- 39 are affiliated to WPCS, all entries must clearly state name and numbers of the exhibit STRICTLY PRE ENTRIES ONLY.**
